Interactive discussion on China- Pakistan Economic Corridor at IOBM



Karachi, Dec.01: Chinese Commercial Consular, Senator Taj Haider and foreign policy expert Dr Talat Ayesha Wazarat spoke at an interactive session on “China Pakistan Economic corridor (CPEC)” by Egalitarians, the economic society of IOBM, on Tuesday.

Wang Zhihua Commercial Consular of the Chinese Consulate in Karachi was the chief guest. Aforesaid dignitaries highlighted the strategic and economic importance
